



2020 MOSCATO

Aroma

Spritzly elderflower and rose petals frolic in the glass with fruit salad and fresh limes. This wine screams "drink me!".

Palate

Spritzly and refreshing this wine is alive with fruit tingle flavours and punchy grapefruit. Sure it's sweet, it is Moscato after all but it has a crisp, edgy acidity that energizes and zips across the palate lifting the sweetness and leaving you refreshed.

Viticulture and Winemaking

Frontignac grapes are picked early sourced from the Wirrega vineyards near Bordertown in the Limestone Coast. The wine is fermented in stainless steel to maintain the bright vibrancy of the fruit characters. Fermentation is ceased to give a sweetness purely derived from grapes themselves. It is bottled soon after fermentation, preserving as much of the natural fermentation gases. Additional spritz is added during bottling to ensure lightness on the palate.
